

I recently watched a remake of the movie "A Christmas Carol." It is one of my favorite of Dickens' stories, but as I watched with Lily I was aware of how absolutely frightening it is. In some ways it's like a Christmas horror story. I pondered that with some discomfort. The redemption of Ebeneezer Scrooge at the end of the story is a powerful conversion to kindness and generosity, but it seems he was scared into it by the threat of eternal damnation.

I continue to believe that being scared into kindness is counter productive. And so, I continue to encourage myself and others to live in kindness not because of the consequences of not being kind, but because of the consequences of being kind.

When we are kind to others, nine times out of ten we find that others are kind in return. I am not a Buddhist, but I believe that there is some truth to the concept of Kharma. What we put out does come back. And so as we enter into the chaos that will surround us in the coming weeks, I invite you to revel in the benefit of your kindness. Know that in your generosity and kindness you will be paid back, not in the next life but in this one.
