







Angel Tree

Once again MFCC will sponsor a Salvation Army Angel Tree. The Angel Tree will be in the narthex, decorated with tags that have the names of boys and girls from Jackson County.

Each year families come to the Salvation Army seeking assistance for Christmas. Last year, due in part to your generosity, over 2,000 children were provided with toys and clothing. Teenagers are now included in the program, making the need that much greater.

Tags are distributed to local organizations and businesses who wish to host an Angel Tree. Those of you who desire to participate in the program can take a tag or two from the tree, write your name next to your tag number on the sign-up sheet, buy a gift for the child on your tag, drop your gift off in the church office making sure your tag is taped to the gift. Gifts should be unwrapped. Donations of tape, gift wrap and gift bags are also needed. Please bring your gifts to the church office no later than 11:00am, Thursday, December 12.

Each tag will have several suggested gift ideas for the child. You may use the ideas as a guide when shopping or select a gift not listed, it's up to you. The Salvation Army will distribute your gifts to the children's parents, so the gift can be placed under the family Christmas tree.
