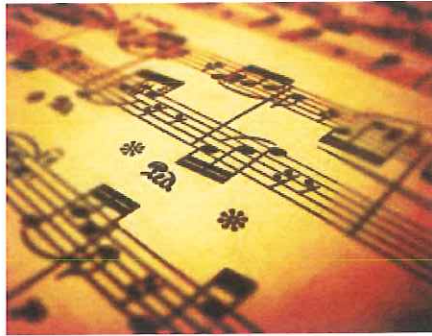
Discover dynamic worship and praise
